

Recycling Details: Where to drop off your Old Belcher

In order to receive the rebate, the old woodstove must be permanently decommissioned and recycled.

The resident or retailer must remove the door, clean out any ash and remove the old firebricks and then deliver the old stove to the nearest recycling facility - either to the Municipal Works Yards or to a scrap metal yard depending on where you live. Ask the staff person in attendance to sign off the third Voucher requirement that the old stove has been recycled.
